ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Generally, admission into the **Doctor of Philosophy** programme requires a student to have a **Master's degree** by research or Master's degree by coursework in related fields with **CPA of at least 3.00**.

Generally, admission into the **Master of Science** programme requires a student to have a **Bachelor's degree** in the related fields with **CPA of at least 3.00**.

International candidates must also meet the **English language requirements**. Candidates must achieve a minimum of **B2 in IELTS, TOEFL or any CEFR-aligned certification**, and **test dated not more than 2 years** of the application date.

Additional Requirements:

Candidates who do not possess academic qualification or work experiences in the relevant fields need to pass the pre-requisite courses in the first year of the candidature. No additional fees are required to attend the courses, which include:
